Dear Partners and Friends,

The School IMC is pleased to announce the appointment of Mr. Cheng Hong Yung (鄭航勇先生) as the Principal of SKH Lam Woo Memorial Secondary School with effect from 1 September 2019, following the retirement of our current Principal, Mr. Chan Ka Yun (陳加恩先生).

This appointment is the result of a rigorous recruitment process following the guidelines of the Education Bureau. It began in June 2018 by a Principal Selection Committee (PSC) comprising Mr. Timothy Ha (also Chair of the Selection Committee), Rev. Peter Cheng, Mr. Peter Cheung and Ms. Linda Chan as appointed by the SKH Secondary School Council (the School Sponsoring Body), and Mr. Timothy Lam Jr. and me (School Supervisor) as appointed by the IMC.

Through advertising in local English and Chinese newspapers, Church newsletter the Echo as well as internal circular, numerous applications were received. Five highly qualified candidates were shortlisted for interviews, and the PSC unanimously concluded to recommend to the School Sponsoring Body that Mr. Cheng Hong Yung be appointed to the post of Principal which the School Sponsoring Body and the IMC unanimously endorsed. Education Bureau has also approved this appointment.

Mr. Cheng, a passionate and committed educator, has been teaching in SKH Lam Woo Memorial Secondary School for 21 years and is currently a vice principal of the School. His passion for educating the next generation is well demonstrated not only in his role as a vice-principal and a teacher, but also in his active participation in curriculum development, teacher professional development, students' careers counselling and support, alumni engagement, etc. He worked in different professional associations including Curriculum Development Council on science education and Hong Kong Physics Olympiad Committee. He has a good working relation with universities and Crown of Thorns Church.

Mr. Cheng graduated from the Chinese University of Hong Kong. He holds a Bachelor of Science and a Master of Philosophy degree, both in physics, an Advanced Postgraduate Diploma in Education and a Master of Art degree in Liberal Studies.

We warmly welcome Mr. Cheng to be our next Principal. With his knowledge and positive relation with the School and our various stakeholders, experience in teaching, curriculum development, school administration and management, and setting clear vision in facilitating well-being of the new generation, we have every trust that Mr. Cheng would lead our school to scale new heights in the coming years.
