- 3. Moreover, parents should not submit applications bearing the same application number to different secondary schools respectively via paper form and SSPA e-Platform. Otherwise, the chance of acquiring a discretionary place will be forfeited.
- 4. Once submitted, disregard in paper form or via the SSPA e-Platform, the applications cannot be cancelled or retrieved, and no change can be made to the order of school preference.
